We invite you to join us for a review of the Draft Preliminary Plans for Reaches 5 and 6 of The Glade stream:

Location: The Basketball Court off of Hunting Horn Lane (see attached map) – we will have a tent and tables set up on the court for plan review and a lunchtime cookout.

Time: 9:00 AM – 2:00 PM (earlier if rain precludes walk)

Date: Saturday – June 27, 2009

Reach 5 starts at Soapstone Drive (across from the fire ring) and ends just upstream of the beaver area. Reach 6 starts below the beaver area and continues downstream to Twin Branches Road. A map of this area is attached to better illustrate the subject reaches.

The purpose of this meeting is to:

1. Show you the Draft Preliminary Plans that reflect existing conditions and the preliminary design – so we can obtain specific comments and respond to them.
2. Discuss staging and access alternatives.
3. Walk the streams (be prepared for stickers, mud, and walking in water) and access areas to visualize them in conjunction with the Draft Preliminary Plans.
